Left & Right are given as if facing the cub/scout wearing the sweatshirt.

On the Left side of the Sweatshirt is the New Zealand Flag Badge, Underneath the flag in vertical line are Kea, Cub, Scout, Venturer Badges showing investiture in these sections. Youth may 'stack' these badges to show their progression in the movement with the topmost badge being the section they entered the movement (lowest their current section).

Underneath the section badges is the service badge. There are 10 of these denoting the number of complete years of membership. Only the most current of these should be worn.

The Left sleeve at the shoulder has the Group Tags "Bishopdale-Harewood"

Underneath the Group Tags is the Cub Pack Name Tag.

Underneath this is the various challenge badges earned in Cubs. Up to three (3) columns are acceptable (no limit to rows).

On the Right side are the Purple WorldScout badge and Chief Scout Badge, level with the New Zealand Flag badge on the Left side.

Underneath is (left to right) Award Scheme Badges Bronze, Silver, Gold

First row is Cub Scheme, Second row is Scout Scheme

Under these are Special Scout training awards Cossgrove and Sandford

and PAL and WOSM World Conservation Medal Awards.

The Right sleeve at the shoulder has the Scout Troop Name Tag.

Underneath this is the various challenge badges earned in Scouts. Up to four (4) columns are acceptable (no limit to rows).

The Back of the Sweatshirt is where you can sew your activity badges, (e.g Jamboree, Trek, JOTI, Mudslide, Camp nights, Special Camps etc).

Bishopdale-Harewood Scout Group Badge Layout - Keas and Cubs

Left & Right are given as if facing the kea/cub wearing the sweatshirt.

On the Left side of the Sweatshirt is the New Zealand Flag Badge,

Underneath the flag in vertical line are Kea, Cub, Scout, Venturer Badges showing investiture in these sections. Youth may 'stack' these badges to show their progression in the movement with the topmost badge being the section they entered the movement (lowest their current section).

Underneath is (left to right) Award Scheme Badges Bronze, Silver, Gold

First row is Kea Scheme, Second row is Cub Scheme

The Right sleeve has the various challenge badges earned in Keas. There are seven challenge badges that can be earned here.

The Back of the Sweatshirt is where you can sew your activity badges, (e.g Jamboree, Trek, JOTI, Mudslide, Camp nights, Special Camps etc).

You will note that the Kea Challenge badges and Scout Challenge badges are on the same arm. Keas badges need to be removed to apply Scout Challenge badges. It is envisaged that most youth starting at keas will have outgrown their sweatshirt by the time they get to Scouts, so removing these badges is not expected to be a common occurrence.
